while the doctor helps other children.

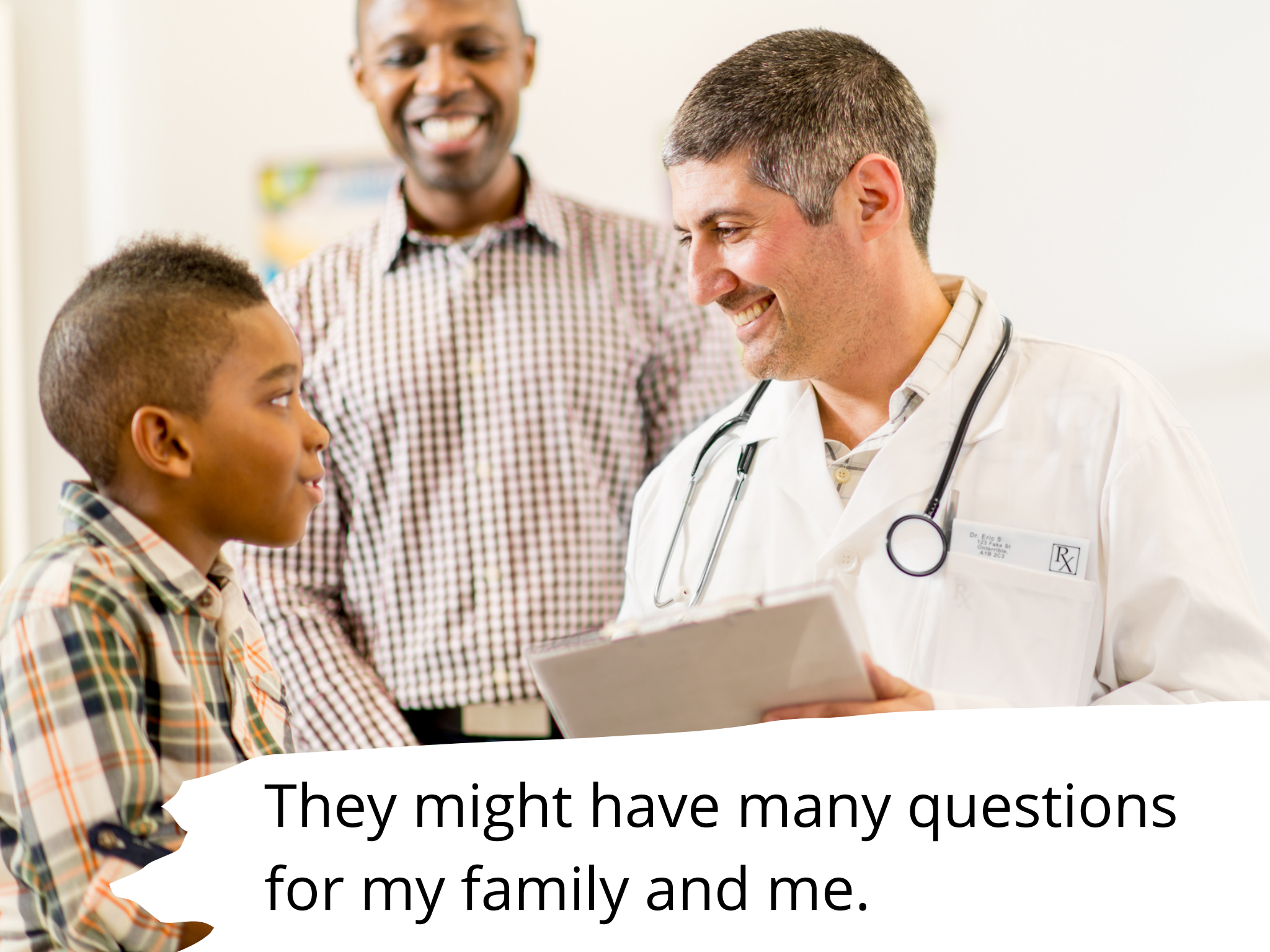


They will see how tall I am and how much I weigh. They might even take my temperature.
